## **TYPHOON SURIGAE**

### Highlights

- US National Weather Service GUAM UPDATE, 630 AM, APRIL 18 Surigae keeps increasing in strength and is now super Typhoon Surigae. Maximum sustained winds are now up to 190 mph near the center. Surigae is over 1100 miles away from the Marianas and poses no direct threat. However, swell generated by the super typhoon is pushing into the Marianas producing hazardous surf of 9 to 11 feet on west facing reefs. The super typhoon will remain distant but the hazardous surf will persist through the coming weekend.
- Palau Public Utilities Corporation UPDATE, 11 AM, April 18 Many areas in Koror, Airai, and all throughout Babeldaob still have no power. PPUC crews continue to repair damaged lines and hardware and clearing of transmission lines. Note that several power poles in Ngaraard and Ngarchelong experienced major damages.
- PRCS Team reports back to NEMO EOC to continue to compile and collate IDA Reports coming from State RDATs, starting at 12 PM, April 18.


