

TYPHOON SURIGAE

Highlights

- On 3 PM, April 28, Executive Director J. Maireng Sengebau, and Assistant Disaster Management Officer JB Victorino met with state Governors at National Emergency Management Office (NEMO) to discuss description of category level damages to households in their respective states and provide data summaries for each state for verification by them.
- April 28, in the evening, PRCS logistics team continue to pack hygiene kits that distributed to category 2 level damaged households in Babeldaob.



 On April 29, PRCS field operation team led by Dissemination and Communications Officer Allyne Andrew went to Peleliu State in the morning by NEMO boat for distribution of NFIs (Non-food items) and hygiene kits to category 2 (1 household) and category 1 (36 households) level of Typhoon Surigae damaged households in Peleliu State. Hygiene kits (140) were also distributed to category 0 damage level households. The Peleliu RDATs were there to meet and help the team with distribution. (See photos on next page)

- April 26, International Federation of Red Cross (IFRC) published Republic of Palau: Typhoon Surigae – Emergency Plan of Action (EPoA), DREF Operation n° 1 MDRPW001. April 29, President Surangel Whipps, Jr. shared the link of the report on his social media page (facebook.com/surangeljr).
- April 30, President Surangel Whipps, Jr., along with Senate President Hokkons Baules and House of Delegates Speaker Sabino Anastacio, presented a 150,000 USD check to Palau Red Cross Society (PRCS) at the Office of the President (satellite office). This government contribution will provide rapid relief assistance to households impacted by typhoon Surigae. Chairman of the National Governing Board Santy Asanuma, Chairman of the North Branch Governing Board Jefferson Thomas, Executive Director J. Maireng Sengebau, and Finance Manager Cindy Fritz-Bai received the check on behalf of PRCS.
- April 30, in the morning, 4 PRCS vehicles carrying ten PRCS staff and a volunteer led by Incident Commander Stephanie J. Minor and Assistant Disaster Management Officer JB Victorino deployed to Babeldaob. 3 of the vehicles were loaded with NFIs and Hygiene kits. A staff was dropped off at each state to support state RDATs in distribution.
